

CHÂTEAU D'OUCHY

The majestic Château d'Ouchy, surrounded by Lake Geneva, the Alps and the city of Lausanne, is an emblem of Lausanne.

At the heart of the Ouchy waterfront district, the château captivates with its romantic history and its convivial atmosphere, perpetually animated by cultural events.

A superior four-star hotel housed in an authentic 12th-century building, the Château d'Ouchy sits on the shores of Lake Geneva, **nestled within the lush grounds of a beautiful park with a swimming pool**. At once enchanting and forward-looking, this jewel houses 49 rooms with strong character, including 10 Junior Suites and 3 Suites steeped in the spellbinding atmosphere of the keep, 1 bar, 1 restaurant, function rooms and a wellness area.

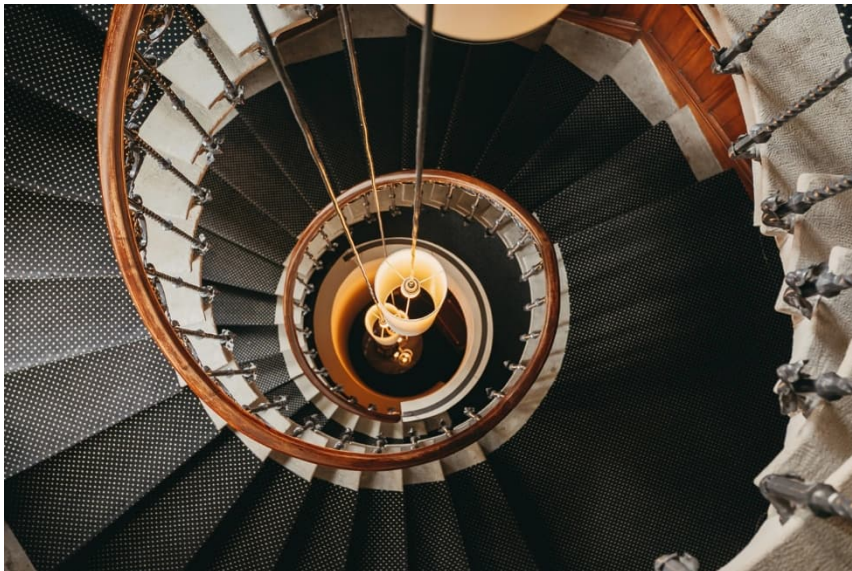


A PLACE OF HISTORY

Although the keep is the only remaining historical vestige, **the château holds a thousand tales** for its visitors. **The Château d'Ouchy is listed as a Swiss cultural property of regional importance.**

In 1177, Bishop Landri de Durnes **had a tower built on the shores of Lake Geneva**. A century later, the building was transformed and fortified to house the Bishops of Lausanne. **After the Middle Ages**, the château became the property of the Bernese bailiffs, then of the Canton of Vaud. It was **Jean-Jacques Mercier** who gave the Château d'Ouchy its current neo-Gothic style and its role as a hotel. Between 1889 and 1893, Monsieur Mercier had the old buildings razed — with the exception of the keep — and **erected a full hotel infrastructure.**

It was in 2015 that **Sandoz Foundation Hotels** acquired the property, completing its Ouchy collection in the finest manner.



OLYMPIC CONNECTIONS

The Olympic Capital, **Lausanne is home to the IOC headquarters**, located close to the hotel. The Olympic Committee draws significant business tourism, as does the nearby international school of management. **The Château d'Ouchy holds a special place in the life of Pierre de Coubertin, founder of the IOC.**

Upon his retirement from the organisation, **Coubertin founded the Universal Pedagogical Union**. Based in Lausanne, he organised at the Château d'Ouchy, in September 1926, a first conference on **the educational role of the modern City, proclaiming for every citizen the “right to sport” and the “right to access general culture”**.

THE SUITES

When the Château d'Ouchy opened its doors in 1893, the "Château" style — then steeped in medieval nostalgia — was very much in vogue. Inspired by the works overseen by French architect Eugène Viollet-le-Duc, the transformation of the "ideal château" into a hotel stands as an exemplary instance of the genre. Adorned with striking gargoyles, intricate woodwork and floral frescoes, the recently renovated Suites of the Château d'Ouchy are, in this respect, true gems well worth discovering!

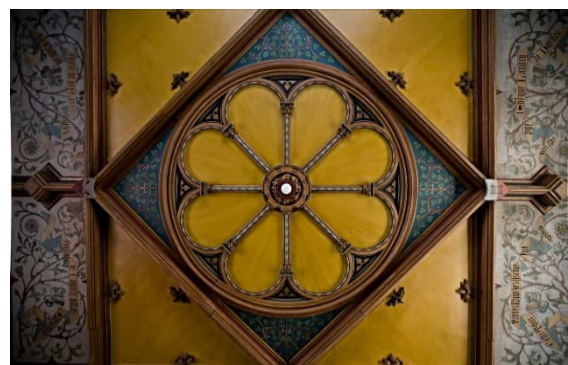
Chevalier Suite

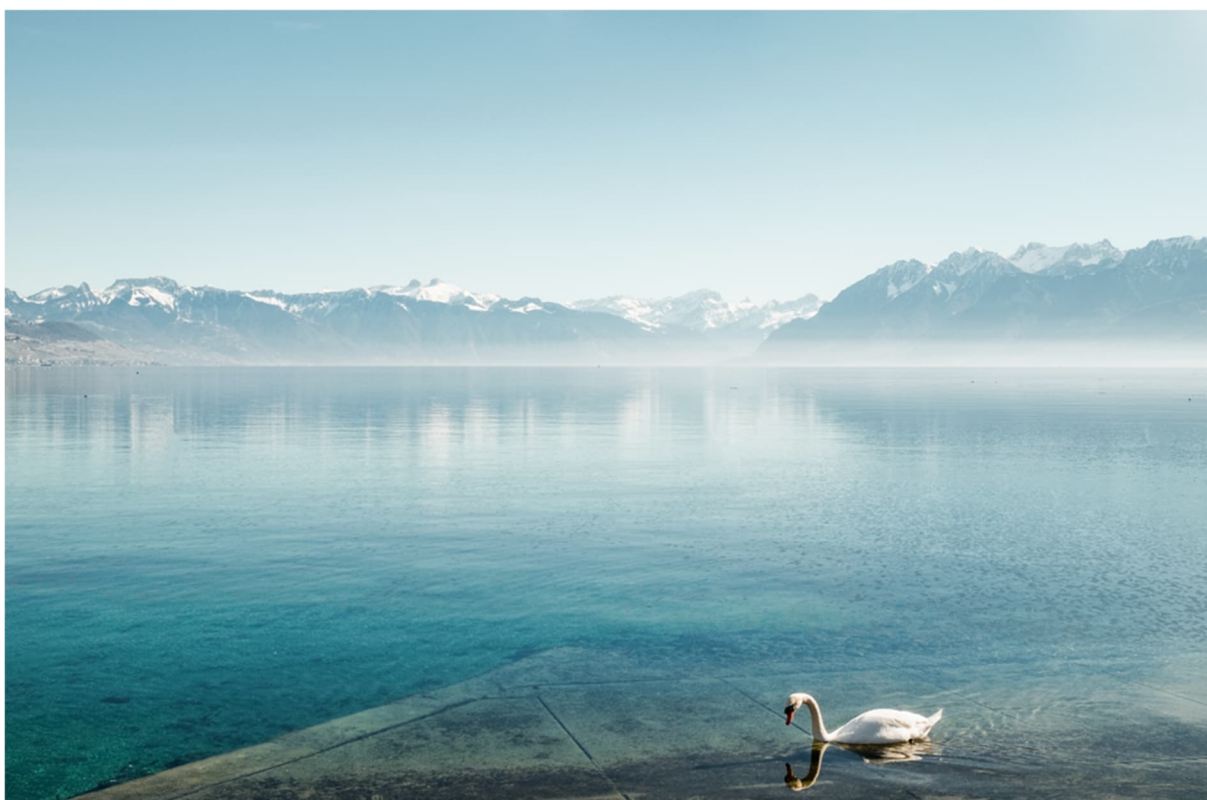
Riviera Suite

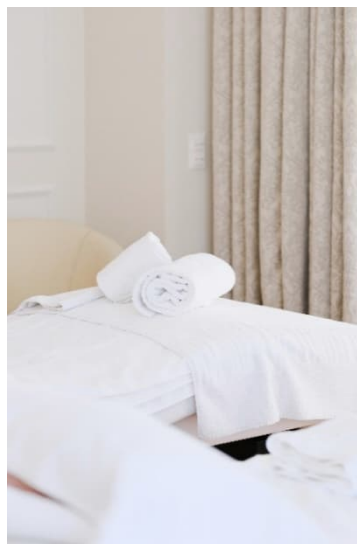
Le Boudoir Alpeor

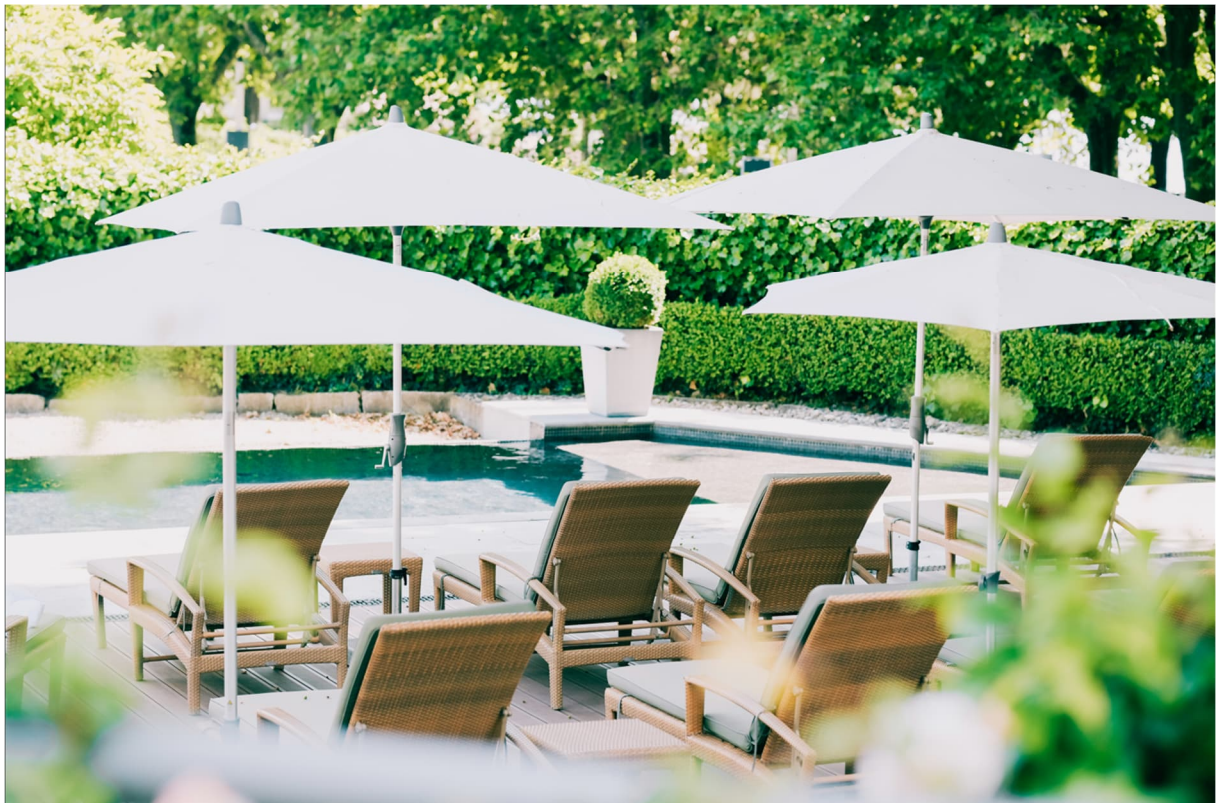
Sauna & Hammam

57 GRILL

The 57° Grill asserts a bold and generous culinary identity, rooted in the finest Swiss produce. Its name is a tribute: 57 degrees, the perfect core temperature for beef, a symbol of fire cooking mastered down to the last detail.

The menu revolves around an open rotisserie and a wood-fired grill, where aged meats, free-range poultry and lake fish follow one another with the seasons. All Limousine-breed beef cuts are aged on the bone for a minimum of 21 days by a partner artisan butcher — a commitment that shows in every plate, from the fillet to the côte de bœuf served to share. Poultry — spit-roasted chicken or poussin — turns slowly in the purest rotisserie tradition.

Territorial roots are a constant: Alpstein lamb, lake perch, brook char from Maison Guibert, Bremblens carrots, honey and thyme from the garden. Producers are selected from small Swiss family farms, chosen for their commitment to animal welfare.

Generosity is in the DNA of the house: from the sharing cuts — tomahawk, T-bone or côte de bœuf — to the Menu entre Amis (3 starters, 3 meats, 3 sides, unlimited chocolate mousse, for 4 or more), the 57° Grill invites conviviality without compromising on quality. **For larger tables, meats and sides can be presented in a casserole dish at the centre of the table**, a way to extend the pleasure of sharing and recapture, for the duration of a meal, the warm spirit of a great feast.
